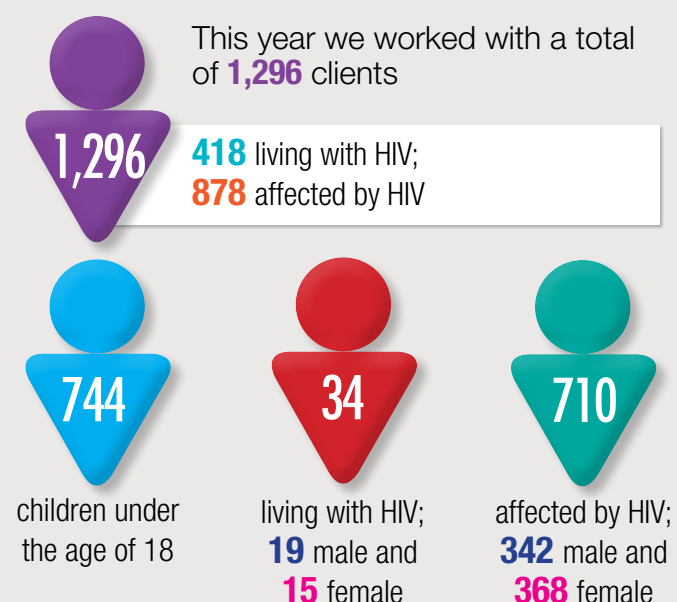

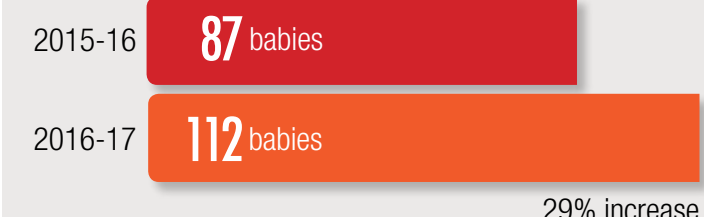

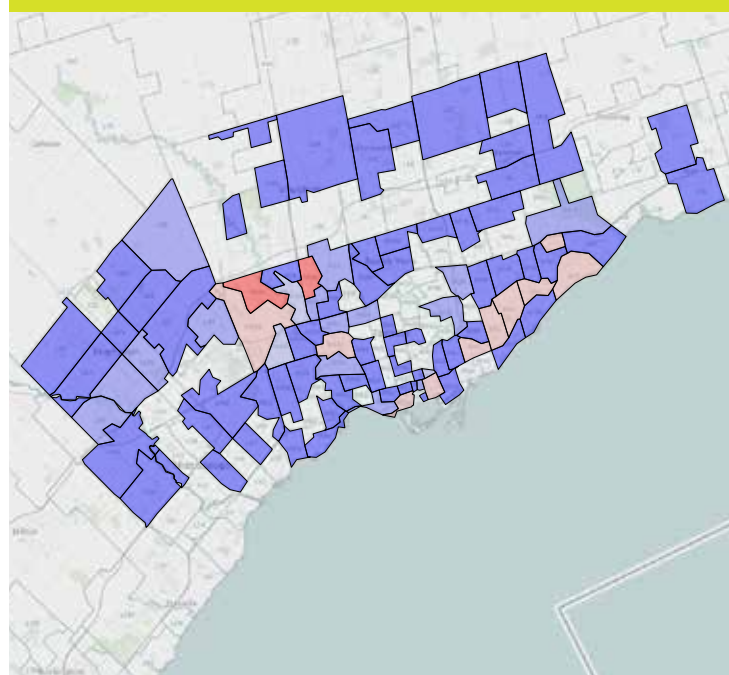

Moms Group **27** Moms and their babies participated in this monthly mutual support group

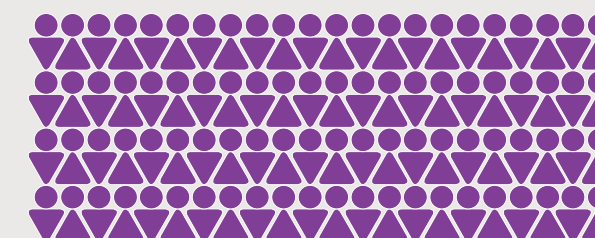
Parent Club **22** parents participated in this monthly mutual support group that focused on a range of different topics led by parents themselves

International Programs



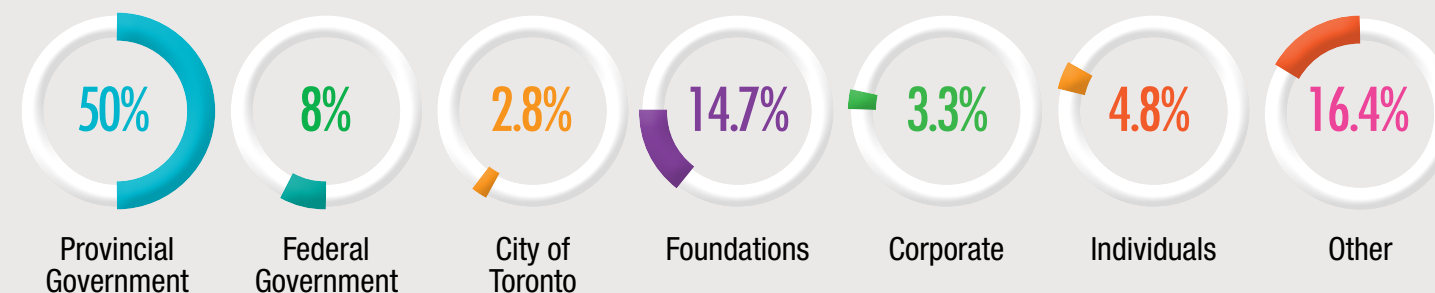
The Teresa Group is the fiscal agent/trustee and an active member of the global Coalition for Children Affected by AIDS. Every two years The Teresa Group and the Coalition co-organise a global symposium before the large international AIDS conference. In July 2016, the symposium entitled “Children and HIV: Equity Now!” was held in Durban, South Africa.

300	delegates attended from 25 different countries
55	scholarships awarded, recipients from 16 countries
75	abstracts submitted, 48 selected for oral presentations and 10 selected as posters
15	volunteers – local students and ASO staff

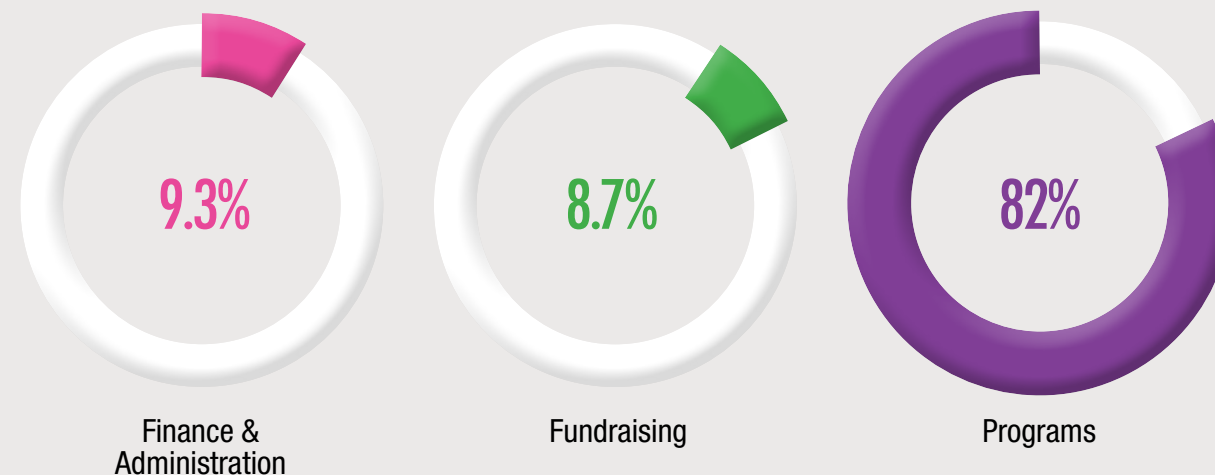
